## CHELSEA ARTS CLUB

Chelsea Arts Club Chairman Matt Ambown unveiled a blue plaque at 181 King's Road, the site of the Club's founding in November 1890.

The Club began as a dining group on March 18, 1891, and within nine months, Claude Monet dined there as a guest. The Club remained at this location until 1902, when it moved to its current home at 143-4 Old Church Street, where the original dining table is still displayed.

Today, the Club serves as a creative sanctuary, supported by Lornham through the management of Chelsea Galleries.
